Entries for the undergraduate with the highest grade point average and undergraduate chapter with the highest grade point average are due May 25, 2009. Documentation includes news articles, programs, thank you letters, chapter agendas, letters of commendation, etc.**

#### **YOU MUST BE PRESENT TO RECEIVE THE FOLLOWING AWARDS:**

##### **BASILEUS OF THE YEAR**

Requirements:

1. Basileus must be nominated by her chapter.
2. Please list and give location of workshops involving leadership skills attended.
3. Please list regional and national workshops attended within the last five years.
4. List specific ways the basileus has affected the chapter (membership growth, program increases, image enhancement, fiscal management, etc.)

##### **UNDERGRADUATE OF THE YEAR**

Requirements:

1. Must be currently enrolled at an accredited college or university
2. Must have performed extra duties to promote Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. and her local chapter.
3. Must possess qualities and uphold the high ideals of FINER WOMANHOOD.
4. Must have letters of recommendation from the chapter advisor and sponsoring chapter basileus.

##### **YOUTH ADVISOR OF THE YEAR**

Requirements:

1. List outstanding skills and leadership abilities.
2. List involvement in youth community service projects and Zeta activities.
3. List involvement in national, regional, and local youth retreats/activities.

##### **AMICAE OF THE YEAR**

Requirements:

1. List outstanding skills and leadership abilities.
2. List involvement in Amicae community service projects and Zeta/Amicae relationships
3. List involvement in national, regional, and local workshops/conferences

##### **UNDERGRADUATE ADVISOR OF THE YEAR**

Requirements:

1. List outstanding skills and leadership skills
2. List involvement in the academic careers of undergraduate sorors.
3. List undergraduate workshops and seminars sponsored or attended.

##### **UNDERGRADUATE WITH THE HIGHEST GPA (Deadline is May 25, 2009)**

Requirements:

1. Must provide an official transcript, which must include Spring 2009 grades.

##### **UNDERGRADUATE CHAPTER WITH THE HIGHEST GPA (Deadline is May 25, 2009)**

Requirements:

1. Official transcript must be submitted by the undergraduate advisor for each soror in the chapter.

### **RECLAMATION/MEMBERHSIP AWARDS**

1. Most reclaimed (graduate)
2. Largest intake (graduate and undergraduate)
3. Largest undergraduate chapter (2008-2009). This information will be obtained from Michelle Joubert, Regional Financial Secretary.
4. Largest graduate chapter (2008-2009). This information will be obtained from Michelle Joubert, Regional Financial Secretary.

### **UNDERGRADUATE TRAVEL AWARD**

An award will be given to the Chapter that traveled the farthest distance to the Regional Conference.

### **LARGEST NUMBER OF REGISTERED SORORS (One graduate chapter and one undergraduate chapter)**

This award will be based on the total number of pre-registered sorors.
